I remember a friend of mine who, I think it was 1993, quit smoking and decided to make his small town diner non-smoking. Imagine, business owners making their own decisions!!

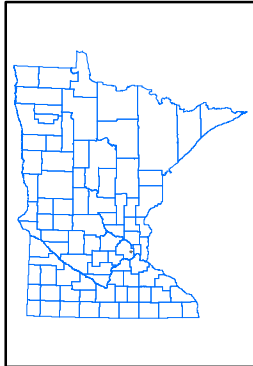
So yeah, screw the ban. It makes me so angry that I want to start smoking. I'm all for your cause."
